SAN ANTONIO TRUST CLAIMS \$15.75 MILLION LOTTO TEXAS[®] JACKPOT FROM AUGUST

(AUSTIN) – Piedmont Sycamore Trust, Dustin Whittenburg, Trustee, of San Antonio, claimed the \$10,671,627.75 Cash Value Option for the \$15.75 million estimated annuitized [Lotto Texas[®]](#) jackpot from Aug. 16. The trust selected all six numbers drawn (1-2-4-27-40-42) on a ticket purchased at the Texas Sun located at 3263 Roosevelt Ave. in San Antonio. For selling the winning ticket the store is eligible for a retailer bonus of \$157,500.

Lotto Texas drawings are held every Wednesday and Saturday evening at 10:12 p.m. Players select six numbers from one to 54 for the chance to win *Lotto Texas*. For \$1 more per play, the Extra! add-on feature provides a chance to increase non-jackpot prizes up to \$10,000.

The claimant requested minimal publicity.
