ORCHARD TRUST CLAIMS \$7.25 MILLION

LOTTO TEXAS[®] JACKPOT SOLD IN EAST BERNARD

(AUSTIN) – The Triple C-Double K Property Trust, James Edward Ressler, Trustee, of Orchard, has claimed a \$7.25 million [Lotto Texas[®]](#) jackpot from the April 29 drawing. Since the Cash Value Option was selected at the time of purchase, the trust will receive \$5,088,900.57.

For selling the winning ticket, the Timewise Food Store #4801 at 955 Highway 90A received a \$72,500 retailer bonus.

The Quick Pick matched all six of the numbers drawn (8-25-42-45-47-53).

The claimant requested minimum publicity.

Lotto Texas is played by picking six numbers from one to 54 and offers multi-million dollar jackpots. Drawings are every Wednesday and Saturday at 10:12 p.m. CT. For \$1 more per play, a player can select the Extra! add-on feature and win up to \$10,000 more on non-jackpot prizes.
