PASADENA RESIDENT CLAIMS \$1 MILLION SCRATCH TICKET PRIZE

(AUSTIN) – Mark E. Moody of Pasadena claimed a prize worth \$1 million in the Texas Lottery® scratch ticket game [\\$500,000,000 Extreme Ca\\$h Blast](#). For selling the winning ticket, Quicky Mart Shell, located at 2449 E. Sam Houston Pkwy S. in Pasadena, is eligible for a \$10,000 retailer bonus.

Moody claimed the 23rd of 40 prizes worth \$1 million available in the game. Five prizes worth \$2.5 million also remain unclaimed in the game.

The claimant requested minimal publicity.

\$500,000,000 Extreme Ca\$h Blast offers more than half a billion in total prizes for the game. Overall odds of winning any prize in \$500,000,000 Extreme Ca\$h Blast are one in 2.84, including break-even prizes.

About the Texas Lottery

Beginning with the first ticket sold in 1992, the Texas Lottery has generated \$24 billion in revenue for the state and distributed \$48 billion in prizes to lottery players.
