\$47 MILLION LOTTO TEXAS® JACKPOT-WINNING TICKET SOLD IN SEGUIN

(AUSTIN) – The \$47 million estimated annuitized jackpot-winning ticket for the Lotto Texas[®] drawing held on Wednesday, Sept. 30, the second-largest lottery prize up for grabs in the world, was purchased at Pic N Pac 10, located at 109 Highway 123 N. Bypass, in Seguin. The winning ticket matched all six of the numbers drawn (4-11-16-19-27-30). The cash value option was selected at the time of purchase and the claimant will receive \$39,767,339.23 before taxes. The prize has not yet been claimed. The winner has 180 days from the draw date to claim the prize.

"After an historic Lotto Texas jackpot run, I look forward to meeting Texas' newest jackpot winner," said Gary Grief, executive director of the Texas Lottery. "If you have the winning ticket, we encourage you to sign the back of the ticket, put it in a safe place, seek financial and legal advice, and call the Texas Lottery to schedule an appointment to claim the prize."

The winning Lotto Texas jackpot started as an advertised \$5 million prize for the drawing on Jan. 18 and rolled a record 73 times before getting hit on Wednesday evening. At \$47 million, it was the largest Lotto Texas prize up for grabs since a \$97 million jackpot-winning ticket for the May 29, 2010 drawing was sold at 7-Eleven Convenience Store #21972, located at 8902 Garland Road, in Dallas, and was claimed by The Bilmar Trust. This is the game's first jackpot winner of more than \$30 million since the May 16, 2018 drawing, when an advertised \$30.25 million prize was claimed by a Houston resident who purchased the winning ticket at MJ's All Season Food Store in Houston.

In addition to Wednesday night's jackpot-winning prize, 133,303 Lotto Texas tickets, including those with the Extra! add-on feature, won lower-tier prizes ranging from \$11,505 to \$2 for the same drawing.

Lotto Texas is played by picking six numbers from one to 54 and offers multimillion-dollar jackpots. Drawings are held every Wednesday and Saturday at 10:12 p.m. CT. For \$1 more per play, a player can select the Extra! add-on feature and win up to \$10,000 more on non-jackpot prizes.
