SAN ANTONIO RESIDENT CLAIMS \$7.5 MILLION SCRATCH TICKET PRIZE

(AUSTIN) – Deborah L. Kempel of San Antonio claimed a top prize worth \$7.5 million in the Texas Lottery® scratch ticket game [Diamond Dollars](#). For selling the winning ticket, Triple S Express located at 6480 Babcock Road in San Antonio is eligible for a \$10,000 retailer bonus.

Kempel claimed the second of three top prizes worth \$7.5 million available in the game. The claimant requested minimal publicity.

Diamond Dollars offers more than \$142.7 million in total prizes. Overall odds of winning any prize in Diamond Dollars are one in 2.52, including break-even prizes.

About the Texas Lottery

Beginning with the first ticket sold in 1992, the Texas Lottery has generated \$24 billion in revenue for the state and distributed \$47 billion in prizes to lottery players.
