FERRIS RESIDENT CLAIMS \$1 MILLION SCRATCH TICKET PRIZE

(AUSTIN) – Monique Coumpy-Foster of Ferris claimed a prize worth \$1 million in the Texas Lottery® scratch ticket game [\\$500,000,000 Cash](#). For selling the winning ticket, Ferris Food Mart located at 101 N. Interstate Highway 45 in Ferris is eligible for a \$10,000 retailer bonus.

Coumpy-Foster claimed the seventh of 40 prizes worth \$1 million available in the game. Nine prizes worth \$2.5 million also remain unclaimed in the game. The claimant requested minimal publicity.

\$500,000,000 Cash offers half a billion in total prizes. Overall odds of winning any prize in \$500,000,000 Cash are one in 2.76, including break-even prizes.

About the Texas Lottery

Beginning with the first ticket sold in 1992, the Texas Lottery has generated \$24 billion in revenue for the state and distributed \$47 billion in prizes to lottery players.
