ABILENE RESIDENT CLAIMS \$1 MILLION SCRATCH TICKET PRIZE

(AUSTIN) – Chaz Russell of Abilene claimed a \$1 million prize in the Texas Lottery® scratch ticket game [\\$200,000,000 Cash Blowout](#). For selling the winning ticket, the 7-Eleven #57 located at 8101 Hwy. 83/84 in Abilene is eligible for a \$10,000 retailer bonus.

Russell claimed the sixth of 10 top prizes worth \$1 million available in the game. The claimant requested minimal publicity.

\$200,000,000 Cash Blowout offers more than \$200,000,000 in total prizes. Overall odds of winning any prize are one in 2.82, including break-even prizes.
