LUBBOCK RESIDENT CLAIMS \$1 MILLION POWERBALL® PRIZE

(AUSTIN) – Kenneth R. Leivo II of Lubbock claimed a second-tier [Powerball®](#) prize worth \$1 million. The ticket was purchased at Stripes #2439 located at 6317 Milwaukee Ave. in Lubbock for the Aug. 29 drawing.

Leivo's Quick Pick matched all five of the white ball numbers drawn (18-21-25-28-29), but not the red Powerball number (16).

The claimant requested minimal publicity.

Powerball jackpots start at \$40 million and roll until the jackpot is won. Players win the jackpot by matching the five white ball numbers (1-59) and the red Powerball number (1-35). There are eight other ways to win non-jackpot prizes ranging from \$4 to \$1 million or up to \$2 million if the ticket includes Power Play. The overall odds of winning a prize in the game are approximately one in 31. The overall odds of winning the jackpot prize are one in 175,223,510.
