\$2.5 MILLION SCRATCH TICKET PRIZE CLAIMED IN SINTON

(AUSTIN) – Dhruvit Patel of Pensacola, Fla. claimed a \$2.5 million prize in the Texas Lottery® scratch ticket game [\\$500,000,000 Cash](#). For selling the winning ticket, the Times Market located at 15927 U.S. Hwy. 181 in Sinton, Texas is eligible for a \$10,000 retailer bonus.

Dhruvit claimed the first of 10 prizes worth \$2.5 million available in the game. Thirty-six prizes worth \$1 million also remain unclaimed in the game.

The claimant requested minimal publicity.

\$500,000,000 Cash offers half a billion in total prizes. Overall odds of winning any prize in *\$500,000,000 Cash* are one in 2.76, including break-even prizes.
