## **\$11.75 MILLION WINNING LOTTO TEXAS® TICKET SOLD IN TOMBALL**

(AUSTIN) – An \$11.75 million jackpot winning ticket for the [Lotto Texas®](#) drawing held March 30 was sold in Tomball. The winner selected the cash value option at the time of purchase and will receive an estimated \$8.49 million. For selling the winning ticket, the Quick Corner Store located at 24814 Kuykendahl Road will receive \$118,342.54. The Quick Pick matched all six of the numbers drawn (5-14-16-17-39-46).

“We want to congratulate the winner of last night’s Lotto Texas jackpot and we look forward to meeting them,” said Gary Grief, executive director of the Texas Lottery. “If you have the winning ticket, we encourage you to seek financial and legal advice before coming to Austin to claim the prize.”

The claimant has 180 days from the draw date to claim the prize.

In addition to the jackpot winning prize, four tickets worth \$11,649 were sold and 14 tickets matched five of six numbers drawn to win \$1,649.

Lotto Texas is played by picking six numbers from one to 54 and offers multi-million dollar jackpots. Drawings are every Wednesday and Saturday at 10:12 p.m. CT. For \$1 more per play, a player can select the Extra! add-on feature and win up to \$10,000 more on non-jackpot prizes.

### About the Texas Lottery
