VICTORIA DOG FEATURED ON TEXAS LOTTERY SCRATCH TICKET

New \$2 scratch ticket now available at Texas Lottery retailers

(AUSTIN) – Murray, a rescued, special needs Chihuahua, owned by Cindy Saunders of Victoria, is one of six dogs and six cats featured on the new Texas Lottery® scratch ticket game, [Cats vs. Dogs](#). The \$2 scratch ticket is now available at Texas Lottery retailers and offers more than \$9.1 million in total prizes and six top prizes of \$30,000.

Murray and the 11 other cats and dogs featured on the game were the top vote getters in the Texas Lottery’s Facebook photo contest held in November 2015.

“More than 1,700 dogs and cats were entered into the photo contest and nearly 25,000 votes were cast,” said Gary Grief, executive director of the Texas Lottery. “With the tremendous response to our photo contest, we expect this game to be a hit with our players.”

Murray is without the use of his legs most of the time and utilizes a wheelchair.

“No matter what though, he fights through it and never gives up. He is the strongest lil’ guy I have ever seen,” Saunders said.

She adds that Murray “loves when I take him walking in his wheelchair. Oh, and he loves to get his brothers in trouble by barking when they are doing something wrong!”

Saunders said that the best thing about owning a cat or dog is that they are “funny and caring” and know how to cheer her up.
