UNCLAIMED \$1 MILLION POWERBALL TICKET EXPIRES JUNE 8

Winning ticket was purchased in Dallas

(AUSTIN) –The last chance to claim a \$1 million winning Powerball® ticket expires tomorrow. A ticket matching five of the six numbers drawn for the Dec. 10, 2016 drawing was purchased at Dollar & Dollars, located at 3462 Webb Chapel Ext. in Dallas, but the \$1 million prize has not been claimed. The winning numbers for the drawing were 12-21-32-44-66, Powerball 15.

“We encourage Powerball players to take another look at their ticket, check the numbers again and if your numbers match, sign the back of the ticket and contact us,” said Gary Grief, executive director of the Texas Lottery.

A ticket holder forfeits any claim to a prize for a draw game after the expiration of the 180th day following the draw date. The deadline may be extended for a period of time for certain "eligible" military personnel. Unclaimed prizes revert back to the state for programs authorized by the Texas Legislature.

The current Powerball jackpot is an estimated \$375 million with a cash value of \$234.5 million. Powerball jackpots start at \$40 million and roll until the jackpot is won. Players win the jackpot by matching five numbers from a field of 69 numbers and one Powerball number from a field of 26 numbers. Drawings occur each Wednesday and Saturday at 10:12 p.m. CT.
