## **GARLAND RESIDENT CLAIMS WEEKLY GRAND SCRATCH TICKET PRIZE**

### **Winning ticket was purchased in Wylie**

(AUSTIN) – Arthur Jackson Jr., of Garland, claimed a top prizewinning ticket worth \$1,000 per week for 20 years in the Texas Lottery® scratch ticket game, [Weekly Grand](#). The claimant chose the cash value option and will receive one lump sum payment of \$803,466.58.

The ticket was purchased at Kwik Chek #19, located at 617 S. Highway 78, in Wylie. The claimant requested minimal publicity.

Jackson claimed the second of five top prizes available in the game. Weekly Grand offers more than \$46.6 million in total prizes. Overall odds of winning any prize in the game are one in 3.95, including break-even prizes.

#### About the Texas Lottery
