ROCKWALL RESIDENT CLAIMS \$1 MILLION SCRATCH TICKET PRIZE

Winning ticket was purchased in Fate, Texas

AUSTIN – A Rockwall resident claimed a top prize winning ticket worth \$1 million in the Texas Lottery® scratch ticket game <u>Cash Royale</u>. The ticket was purchased at Homeboy's Grocery, located at 2975 State Highway 66, in Fate, Texas. The claimant elected to remain anonymous.

This was the first of four top prizes worth \$1 million to be claimed in this game. Cash Royale offers more than \$320.3 million in total prizes. Overall odds of winning a prize of \$75 or more in the game are one in 3.58.

About the Texas Lottery
