WRITTEN QUESTIONS RECEIVED BY SEPTEMBER 30, 2020 @ 4 P.M.

1. Do you know the exact carpet color for the new location yet?

RESPONSE: The carpet color has not been chosen at this time.

2. Where are the power drop locations in the new space? Are they notated on the current specs?

RESPONSE: There will be circuits at the walls, under the raised floor and suspended metal grid system. Also, please refer to RFP Section 6.4.1.

3. Regarding the winning bidder being prohibited from entering the TX lottery. Is there a time frame that it runs from? Is it all games & tickets that are prohibited from entry?

RESPONSE: If the question is related to RFP Section 3.45 Ticket Purchase, this prohibition would be for the Contract Term for all lottery games sold in Texas.

4. What are the dimensions of the current columns on wheels onsite.

RESPONSE: The columns are 7ft. 7 in. high and 8 ft. in circumference.

5. for background check 4.7.1-3, do we need to turn anything into you before the proposal submission or is that completed afterwards?

RESPONSE: No. RFP Section 4.7 is only required of the Successful Proposer and the Texas Lottery will ask for the information if it is needed. Also, please refer to RFP Section 3.12.
