The Texas Lottery makes no commitment to quantity or timing for acquisition of Offered Options. A Proposer is not obligated to include an Offered Option in the Proposal. **Offered Options shall not include video lottery, casino gaming, internet-based lottery sales, or other activities, goods or services not authorized by law.**

- 1.1.1 The Texas Lottery Commission is issuing this Request for Proposals (RFP) to solicit proposals from interested vendors to provide lottery operations services and equipment, including, but not limited to, a Lottery Gaming System and sales, marketing, warehouse, distribution and related services to implement and operate Texas Lottery games **as authorized by law. The scope of this RFP (including all options) does not include video lottery, casino gaming, internet-based lottery sales, or other activities, goods or services not authorized by law.**

The Proposer must describe its proposed Web-based subscription system including the funding, prize payout, and age verification features of the system.</del> <b>The Proposer must describe its mail order subscription database system for lottery players as authorized by Texas Government Code Section 466.3052, including the processing of all subscription orders, age verification of players, and payment of prizes.</b></p>
